The Wire

All Wire is Sterling Silver Dead soft unless otherwise noted.

The Tassel dome

Spokes	6 x 1 ft 22 G
Mystery Wire	1 x 1 ft copper 24 G
Binding Wire	4 in 20 G
Suspension Spiral	4 in 18 G
Weaving Wire	12 ft 24 G in 2 x 6 ft sections
Coiling Wire	10 ft 24 G in 2 x 5 ft sections

Coil using the 22 gauge wire as the mandrel.

The Wire Beads

The Bail	2.5 ft 24 G, 5 in 20 G 1 only
Double Link	1 in each, for 12 links, 1 ft 18 G
Kuchi Coil	For each, 1 ft 26 G, 4 in 22 G, 2 in 18 G
6 Kuchi Coils	6 ft 26 G, 2 ft 22 G, 1 ft 18 G
Long Kuchi Coil	For Each; 7 in 26 G, 5 in 22 G, 1.5 ft 18 G
6 Long Kuchi's	3.5 ft 26 G, 2.5 ft 22 G, 1.5 ft 18 G
The Spiral	2 in 20 G ea, 6 Spirals, 1 ft 20 G
Connecting Wire	3 ft 20 G

The Beads

Choose an assortment of beads that contrast or complement one another.

For the dome; A strand of 2-3 mm semi-precious, a strand of tiny Thai silver.

Both of these need to fit over 24 G.

For the Skirt; Balinese silver, lampwork beads, semi-precious or trade beads.

Gather beads in groups of 6 for the skirt. Focal beads, one for the center.

or a group of focal beads that will appear in the center dangle.

Gather drops in groups of six for the bottom of the skirt. These need to fit over 20 G wire

Silver connectors and dangles.
